- Hold at least one training session a week during the summer season

- Hold a current National Police Clearance or be willing to obtain one.

The Saints Athletics club has access to equipment and grounds required for all athletics events at St Peter's College. This includes access to a gym and swimming pool. Club coaches are welcome to use these facilities to train Saints Athletic Club athletes. Alternatively, coaches may coach club athletes at other suitable locations pending committee approval.
